FAMILY PORTRAITS

These shots are usually taken after the ceremony when everyone is still in one common area. If this is how we do it for your day I will ask the officiant to announce that they will be taking place (after wedding party walks down the isle) so family knows they're coming up and we're not searching for them.

Sit down with your fiancé over dinner or drinks and put together a list of "must have" family shots. I will have this list day of, so you don't have to worry about remembering - I gotchu!

Some Tips:

- Try and keep the list short - of course we want to capture all your loved ones, but you don't have to have a crazy long list just because I ask for a list. The shorter the list, the quicker the process, and the sooner everyone can enjoy cocktail hour! Keep in mind there will be opportunities throughout the evening to get more shots with certain people and friend groups. This is for formal portraits. You can grab me at anytime to grab certain shots, etc.
- If you want to do extended family photos with large groups, consider limiting the various group combinations you may be tempted to have. Consider a few group shots and move on. Photo fatigue is real and you will want to be enjoying your celebration!!
- Designate a family member or close friend to help round up everyone. It will help me greatly as I won't know who uncle Jim is and if they see them they can go grab them.

Other group photo opportunities:

- Dance Floor Speed Shots: During the reception after first danced, but before it gets too crazy I can ask the DJ to play a song and during that time the people who would like a photo with the two of you can jump in for a shot together.
- Table Rounds - if you plan to go around to each table to say hello to your guests, that can be a moment where we take a group photo of you with that table.
